The Friends of the Bennington Battle Monument, a non-profit group, was established in 2005 to support, promote, and enhance new and existing programs and exhibits at the Bennington Battle Monument.

Hiland Hall, a North Bennington native, Governor, Congressman, Supreme Court justice and historian was the driving force behind the building of the monument. The principal architect was J. Philip Rinn of Boston. The cornerstone was laid in 1887 and the capstone was set in 1889. The Monument was formally dedicated and opened to the public in 1891 to coincide with the bicentennial celebration of Vermont's statehood. At 306' in height, it is the tallest man-made structure in the state.
